

Today's reading - Joshua 3:7-17 - recounts the second attempt by God to have the Israelites enter the land he had promised to them. The first attempted entry was scuttled by the people's lack of faith – they didn't believe that God was greater than all the obstacles and dangers facing them.

As we pick up the reading, 40 years later, only two of all the original adults remain alive. God has now raised up Joshua to fulfil His purposes. The difficulties facing the Israelites had not changed but Joshua believed that God would equip and enable him to do all that he was called to do.

What about you and I? What is God's current call on your life? On my life? Do we recognise that we have a call on our lives? Are we overwhelmed by the obstacles and shrink from the task at hand? Or, do we acknowledge the obstacles but believe that the God we serve is more than able?

God is looking for people of all ages and circumstances to step out in faith and work with Him. What is your next adventure with Christ? What is mine?
